Background / Issue:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stillwater Police Department is tasked with responding to emergencies of various natures within the City of Stillwater jurisdiction, which includes Boomer Lake and Lake McMurtry, and also encompasses Oklahoma State University campus. • Stillwater Police Department, as the largest regional law enforcement agency, routinely provides mutual aid assistance to other area agencies. This aid often includes the Special Operations Team. Officers are tasked with quickly responding to situations ranging from navigating dense crowds at OSU Homecoming and football games to locating armed and dangerous fugitives in isolated woodland areas. • The department seeks a grant from Firehouse Subs to cover the purchase of two larger and more robust ATVs. • These ATVs will be outfitted with emergency lights, roofs, windshields, and winches making them capable of carrying officers into nearly any environment.
Proposal/Solution:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stillwater PD requests approval for the submittal of an application for a grant from Firehouse Subs in the amount of \$45,620.64, which covers full cost of the ATV's and shipping to SPD. • The deadline for submittal is August 19, 2020.
Financial Impact/Funding Source(s):	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The ongoing maintenance of these items is minimal and can be absorbed easily into the existing SPD maintenance and repair budget. • There doesn't appear to be any grant restrictions on the use or disposal of the equipment.
Related Strategic Priority:	#3 Safe Community: To identify effective services that enhance relationships, responsiveness and quality customer service to promote a safe and secure community.

Recommended Action/Motion:

Motion to approve submittal of an application to Firehouse subs for a grant with no matching funds required in the amount of \$45,620.64 for the purchase of two ATV's for the Stillwater Police Department.
