A RESOLUTION OF THE STILLWATER PLANNING COMMISSION DETERMINING THAT THE 6TH AVENUE CORRIDOR STUDY IS IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE STILLWATER 2030 C3 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE CITY OF STILLWATER AND RECOMMENDING APPROVAL AND ADOPTION OF THE 6TH AVENUE CORRIDOR STUDY

WHEREAS, it is an objective of the City of Stillwater, Oklahoma (“City”) to promote orderly development within its boundaries in order to attract investment, enhance the tax base, stimulate economic growth, and improve the quality of life in and around the City; and

WHEREAS, the 6th Avenue Corridor Study is a project designed to promote a more robust and complete active transportation network; which contributes to the quality of life in the community, and

WHEREAS, the 6th Avenue Corridor Study promotes increased connectivity between the downtown and OSU campus as well as encourages a more bicycle and pedestrian friendly environment within various redevelopment areas; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has reviewed the Stillwater 2030 C3 Comprehensive Plan, as amended from time to time, and the 6th Avenue Corridor Study; and

WHEREAS, the 6th Avenue Corridor Study is appropriate and desirable in order to support efforts to achieve the objectives of the Stillwater 2030 C3 Comprehensive Plan, as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission finds it appropriate and desirable to recommend to the City Council of the City that it approve and adopt the 6th Avenue Corridor Study.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF STILLWATER, OKLAHOMA:

1. The 6th Avenue Corridor Study is hereby declared to be in conformance with the Stillwater 2030 C3 Comprehensive Plan, as amended from time to time; and
2. Recommendation is hereby made to the City Council of the City of Stillwater that it approve and adopt the 6th Avenue Corridor Study.
