“A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A PURCHASING POLICY FOR THE CITY OF STILLWATER AND ITS TRUSTS.”

WHEREAS, the City of Stillwater has established policies regarding purchases by the City and its trusts; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Councilors and Chair and Trustees of its Trusts intend to adopt said policies establishing general parameters for promulgation of minimum standards related to the acquisition of goods, services, materials, supplies and equipment that shall govern the conduct of City and trust officials.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILLWATER AND THE CHAIR AND TRUSTEES OF THE STILLWATER UTILITIES AUTHORITY AND THE STILLWATER ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY:

Section 1. The “City of Stillwater Purchasing Policy” attached hereto is hereby adopted in its entirety.

Section 2. The Purchasing Policy shall become effective immediately upon passage of this Resolution and shall apply to all purchases after the date of adoption of this Resolution.

Section 3. Staff shall continue to identify opportunities to improve the Purchasing Policy and processes, and the sections of City Code that reference them, if applicable, and present recommendations for such improvements.
