

RESOLUTION NO. CC-2020-9; SUA-2020-1

“A RESOLUTION SUSPENDING DISCONNECTION OF CITY/SUA PROVIDED UTILITY SERVICES FOR NON-PAYMENT UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.”

WHEREAS, the President of the United States and the Governor of the State of Oklahoma have declared an infectious disease national emergency to combat COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, the Mayor declared a public health emergency in the City of Stillwater, Oklahoma to further combat the spread of this virus; and

WHEREAS, there have been twenty-nine confirmed cases of COVID-19 within the State of Oklahoma and one confirmed case in Payne County; and

WHEREAS, health professionals and researchers have determined that COVID-19 is spread by human contact and interaction; and

WHEREAS, avoidance of human contact through methods such as "social distancing" and "sheltering in place" are believed to slow the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, insuring that residents have full access to utility services in their homes and businesses will facilitate these efforts; and

WHEREAS, the spread of COVID-19 is a disaster affecting life, health, and safety of Stillwater residents and non-residents alike.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILLWATER AND THE CHAIR AND TRUSTEES OF THE STILLWATER UTILITIES AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. Disconnection of City/SUA provided public utilities for non-payment of outstanding balance(s) due is hereby suspended until further notice.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective upon passage by both the City Council and SUA Trustees.
