

RESOLUTION NO. CC-2020-11; SUA-2020-4

**“A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LONGER TERM PAYMENT PLANS FOR UTILITY SERVICES; APPROVING REINSTATEMENT OF CUT-OFF NOTIFICATIONS AND RESUMING DISCONNECTIONS BEGINNING JUNE 2, 2020 AND REINSTATING THE 10% PENALTY ON DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS EFFECTIVE JULY 6, 2020.”**

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020, the City/SUA approved Resolutions CC-2020-9 and SUA-2020-1 suspending disconnections of City/SUA provided utility services for nonpayment until further notice due to COVID-19 public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, the conditions underlying said Resolutions have abated to the point that other remedies can be reasonably implemented to address late or non-payment for utility services.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILLWATER AND THE CHAIR AND TRUSTEES OF THE STILLWATER UTILITIES AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. Resolutions CC-2020-9 and SUA-2020-1 dated March 23, 2020 are hereby repealed as follows:

(A) Cut-off notices and disconnection of delinquent accounts for City/SUA provided utility services shall resume June 2, 2020;

(B) The Ten Percent (10%) penalty for delinquent City/SUA provided utility service accounts shall resume July 6, 2020. Penalties shall begin to accrue from the first billing cycle after said date.

SECTION 2. The City Manager/SUA Manager shall develop a program to assist delinquent utility account holders affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. Said program shall include longer term payment options to assist City/SUA utilities customers with delinquent accounts. Program enrollment shall commence June 2, 2020 and end July 17, 2020.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall become effective upon passage by both the City Council and SUA Trustees.
