Background / Issue:	 The convenience collection center (CCC) accepts used motor oil for recycling. Currently, there is no charge to drop off used motor oil, which is collected by Green for Life Environmental. Green for Life Environmental and other similar companies have begun to charge a fee to collect used motor oil. The CCC recycles approximately 4,000 gallons of used motor oil a year. Including the truck dispatch charge and oil collection fee, each gallon cost approximately \$.20 to recycle. Although the individual charge is insignificant to the Waste Management annual budget, there continues to be costs passed on to the City.
Proposal/Solution:	 Upon review, the following options are available: Continue to take the oil for free and budget funds to pay for recycling of used motor oil. Stop accepting used motor oil at the convenience collection center. Continue to accept used motor oil and charge \$.20 per gallon.
Financial Impact/Funding Source(s):	If Resolution No. SUA-2020-5 is approved, the collection fee of \$.20 per gallon will cover the costs incurred by the City to recycle used motor oil effective June 1, 2020.

Recommended Action/Motion:	Motion to approve Resolution No. SUA-20- adopting a \$.20 per gallon charge for used motor oil at the convenience collection center.
