<b>Background / Issue:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• April 5, 2021: LM Vedder consulting presented the newly designed Distributed Generation (DG) rate schedule.</li> <li>• Based on the results of a lengthy public outreach and education program, the recommended DG rate structure is Net Energy Metering with a Fixed Service Availability Fee assessed to DG customers.</li> <li>• LM Vedder and City staff have designed a state-of-the-art rate based off the latest cost of service study that ensures all customers are treated equitably, addresses cross subsidization issues, and directly correlates to feedback received from customers.</li> </ul>
<b>Proposal/Solution:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Consider adopting Resolution 2021-4.</li> </ul>
