

RESOLUTION NO. SUA-2012-3

"A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A RATE STRUCTURE FOR THE WASTE MANAGEMENT DIVISION COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS PILOT PROGRAM."

WHEREAS, the Stillwater Utilities Authority is the operator of the solid waste collection service to residents and businesses located within and outside the corporate limits of the City of Stillwater; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Stillwater Utilities Authority are charged with the duty and responsibility to set solid waste collection and recycling rates for the Stillwater Waste Management Utility; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Stillwater Utilities Authority to ensure that the waste management rates are adequate to meet the financial requirements of the utility and the City; and

WHEREAS, the excess revenues generated by the solid waste collection services are transferred to the City of Stillwater General Fund; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Recyclable Material Collection Pilot Program has been established to evaluate the benefits of a separate collection of recyclable materials for the community, and that the fees listed below shall be charged to all curbside collection customers located within the curbside collection pilot program area and to all commercial customers that elect to participate in the commercial recyclable materials collection pilot program. The trustees of the Stillwater Utilities Authority do hereby establish and set the following Recyclable Materials Collection Pilot Program fees and tariffs effective July 1, 2012:

B. Commercial Recyclable Materials Collection

<u>Container Type</u>	<u>Monthly Fee</u>
8 cu.yd, open top	\$40
13 cu.yd, slotted	\$52
20 cu.yd, slotted	\$80
20 cu.yd, open top	\$100
25 cu.yd, sliding door	\$100
30 cu.yd, slotted	\$120
30 cu.yd, open top	\$150
40 cu.yd, slotted	\$160
40 cu.yd, open top	\$200

Notes:

1. During the pilot program, commercial recycling services shall only be available to commercial waste customers within the City limits.
2. Subject to availability of containers, commercial customers with a 4 cubic yard dumpster are eligible to receive a 13 cubic yard recyclable collection container and service at no additional charge.
3. An additional fee of \$100 may be applied to those customers who utilize recyclable materials containers for disposal of non-recyclable materials.

C. Residential Waste Collection

The residential waste collection fees apply to all 1- and 2-family dwelling units and qualifying commercial businesses receiving curbside waste collection within the designated residential recyclable materials collection pilot program service area. All curbside collection waste customers in the designated pilot program area are eligible to receive a single cart specifically intended for the purpose of collecting recyclable materials at no additional charge.

Notes:

1. Carts designated for recyclable materials that contain non-recyclable materials and are placed by the customer for collection will be removed upon the third occurrence. If a recyclable material collection cart is removed under this provision, the customer will not be eligible for curbside recyclable materials collection service for the remainder of the pilot program.
