

## RESOLUTION NO. CC-2017-4

“A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING REVISIONS TO THE STILLWATER DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS.”

WHEREAS, the Stillwater City Code authorizes adoption of “City of Stillwater Standards” and “City Drainage Standards” establishing requirements for infrastructure improvements such as streets, alleys and sidewalks, water distribution and wastewater collection systems, stormwater management systems and drainage facilities; and

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2011, the City Council adopted the Stillwater Standards; and

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2013, May 6, 2013, and August 19, 2013, the City Council adopted revisions to the Stillwater Standards; and

WHEREAS, draft changes have been developed by City staff and presented to the public for review and comment; and

WHEREAS, the Stillwater City Code, requires that the “City of Stillwater Standards” and “City Drainage Standards” be adopted by resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILLWATER, OKLAHOMA:

Section 1. The following changes to the City of Stillwater Standards and the City Drainage Standards (collectively “Standards”), are hereby adopted as follows:

Replace all references to “Water Utilities Director” with “Water Resources Director”.

Replace all references to the AWWA (American Water Works Association) C900 and C905 PVC pipe specifications with references to the new C900-2016 specification.

Replace the following sections with the attached proposed sections:

- 1107 Buried Pipe Design
- 1400 Drinking Water Distribution System Design
- 1500 Wastewater Collection System Design
- 2107 Buried Pipe Construction
- 2108 Bored or Encased Pipe Construction
- 2400 Drinking Water Distribution System Construction
- 2500 Wastewater Collection System Construction

Replace the following details with the attached proposed details:

- 3103 Pipe Encasement
- 3402 Hydrant Assemblies
- 3406 Service Line and Meter Locations
- 3407 Service Line Street Crossing
- 3409 Meter Box and Customer Valve Box
- 3412 Valve Box
- 3501 Precast Manhole

Remove detail 3811 Storm Sewer Box Culvert

Section 2. The Standards shall become effective immediately upon passage of this resolution and shall apply to all drainage improvements and all public water, wastewater, sidewalk and roadway improvements required by the City Code, for which improvement plans are submitted to the City after the date of adoption of this resolution.

Section 3. Staff shall continue to identify opportunities to improve the Standards and the sections of City Code that reference them, and present to the City Council recommendations for such improvements.
